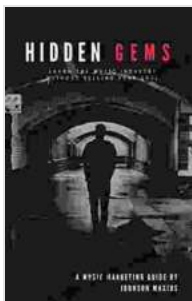


How to Get Into the Music Industry Without Selling Your Soul

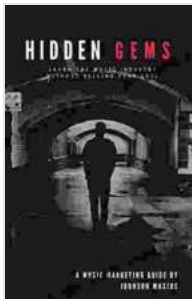
