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Materials

- Size 8 (5.0mm) knitting needles
- Size 9 (5.5mm) knitting needles
- 1000 yards of worsted weight yarn
- Stitch markers
- Tapestry needle

Gauge

18 stitches and 24 rows = 4 inches in stockinette stitch on size 9 (5.5mm) needles.

Finished Size

Bust: 46 (50, 54, 58, 62) inches

Length: 24 (26, 28, 30, 32) inches

Instructions

Back:

1. Using size 8 (5.0mm) needles, cast on 100 (110, 120, 130, 140) stitches.
2. Knit 2 inches in garter stitch.
3. Switch to size 9 (5.5mm) needles and knit in stockinette stitch for 22 (24, 26, 28, 30) inches.
4. Shape the armholes: Bind off 5 stitches at the beginning of the next 2 rows.
5. Knit 10 (12, 14, 16, 18) inches.
6. Shape the shoulders: Bind off 5 (7, 9, 11, 13) stitches at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Bind off the remaining stitches.

Front:

1. Using size 8 (5.0mm) needles, cast on 100 (110, 120, 130, 140) stitches.

2. Knit 2 inches in garter stitch.
3. Switch to size 9 (5.5mm) needles and knit in stockinette stitch for 22 (24, 26, 28, 30) inches.
4. Shape the armholes: Bind off 5 stitches at the beginning of the next 2 rows.
5. Knit 10 (12, 14, 16, 18) inches.
6. Divide the work in half and place markers on each side.
7. Shape the neckline: Knit 10 (12, 14, 16, 18) stitches, place a marker, bind off the next 2 stitches, knit to the end of the row. Knit the next row as it comes.
8. Continue to knit the back and forth rows, decreasing 2 stitches at the beginning of every other row until there are 20 (22, 24, 26, 28) stitches remaining on each side.
9. Bind off the remaining stitches.

Sleeves:

1. Using size 8 (5.0mm) needles, cast on 60 (64, 68, 72, 76) stitches.
2. Knit 2 inches in garter stitch.
3. Switch to size 9 (5.5mm) needles and knit in stockinette stitch for 18 (20, 22, 24, 26) inches.
4. Shape the cap: Bind off 5 stitches at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Continue to decrease 5 stitches at the beginning of every other row until there are 10 (12, 14, 16, 18) stitches remaining.

5. Bind off the remaining stitches.

Finishing:

1. Sew the shoulder seams.



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
