






Purgatorio, an illustration portraying Dante and Virgil's ascent up the mountain of Purgatory. (Public Domain)



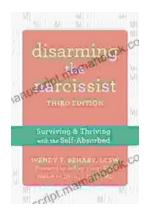
